

## Health Insurance Options and Assistance | Summit County

Connect for Health Colorado is a new online marketplace where individuals, families and small businesses in Colorado can shop, compare, pick and purchase health insurance plans and get exclusive access to new up-front financial assistance, based on income, to reduce costs. The Marketplace opens in October 2013 and will provide a broad range of health insurance options and expert help in person and over the phone. **Health insurance prices depend on where you live, your age, how many people are covered by your plan and whether you use tobacco products.** Nearly 500,000 Coloradans will be eligible for a new kind of tax credit to reduce monthly premiums. Some Coloradans will be eligible for zero-premium health plans. We will also help you access free or low-cost coverage through Medicaid or Child Health Plan Plus.
