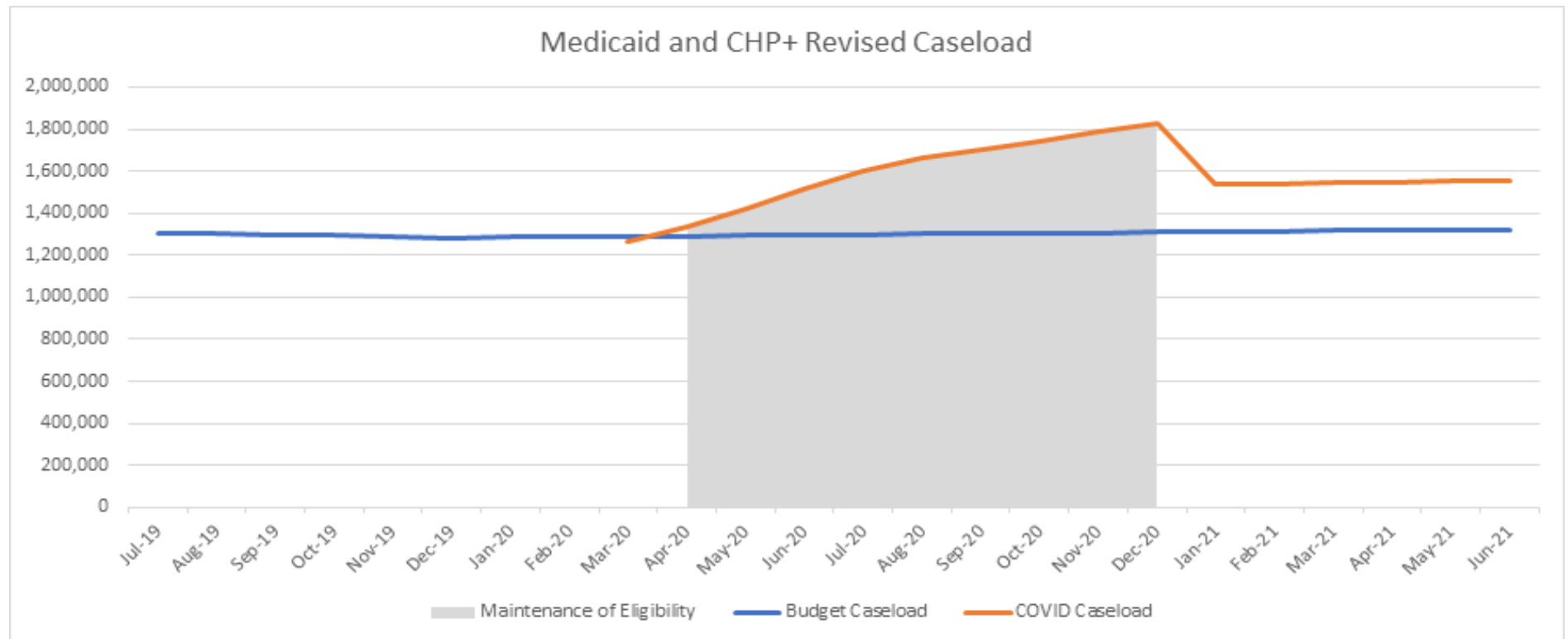


Medicaid, CHP+ Membership Surge Forecast

- Expecting a membership surge of more than 500,000 Coloradans this coming Fiscal Year
- 40%+ increase to the 1.3M members covered by Medicaid and CHP+ as of March 2020
- When the public health emergency period ends (presumed Dec. 31), we project an **estimated disenrollment of more than 300,000** members who do not meet eligibility criteria.
- **Net annual surge of 350,000** Coloradans
