



## DATA TRANSFER FROM CBMS TO C4

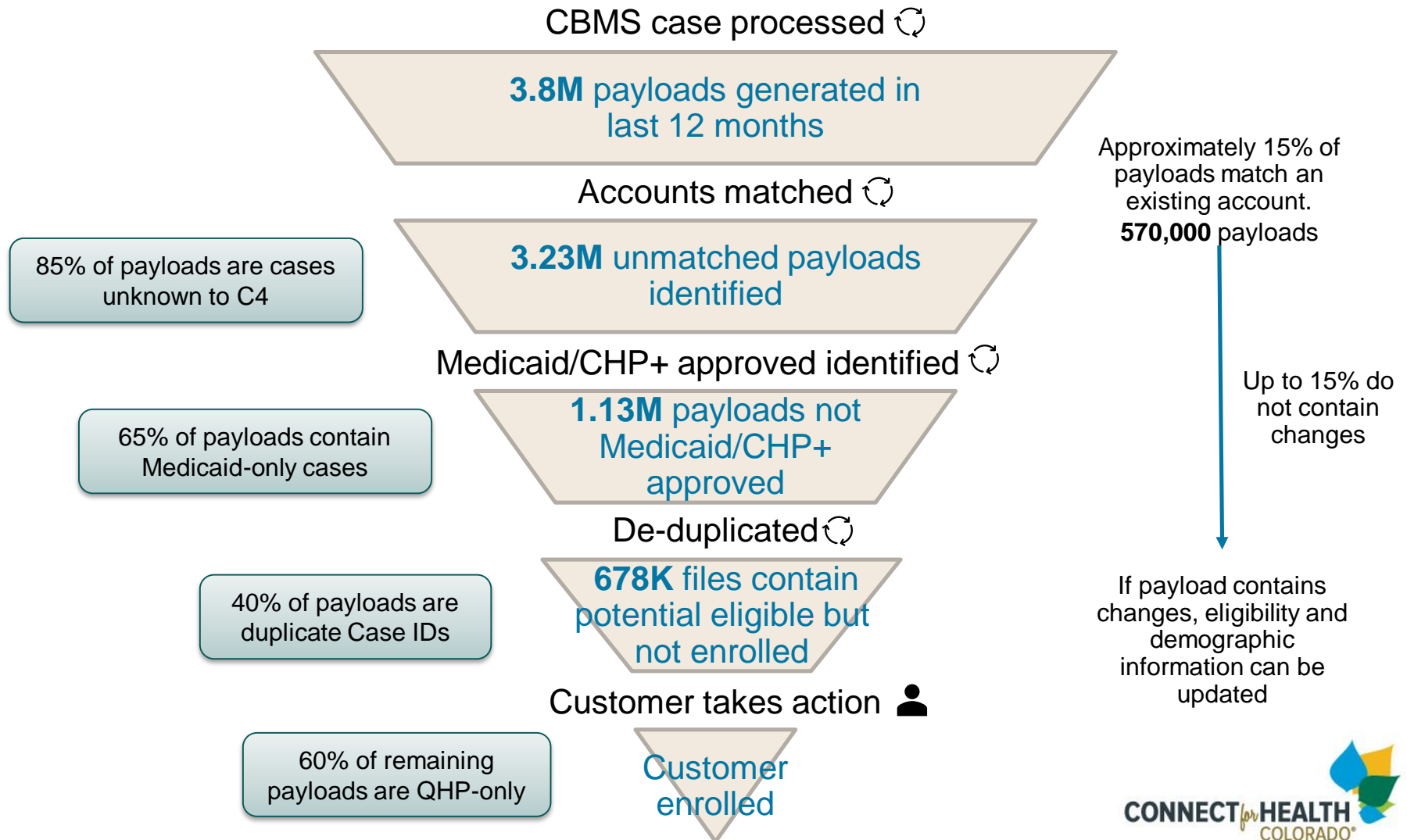
# Objective

As part of the Medicaid termination analysis C4 has been asked to evaluate what data is needed to support the transition of consumers and how our current data sources can support.

The primary current data transfer occurs via the Payload files sent from CBMS to C4.

# Impacts to Medicaid Termination

- Total data received and individuals eligible for C4 programs is not a one to one match. As a result it is challenging to identify and accurately report metrics tied to conversion rates.
- Because all information is delivered with the same method (changes to existing enrolled accounts, changes to existing accounts with no enrollment and new accounts) the call to action for the customer is the same. There is not enough information in the payload to create targeted messaging.
- Enrollment and event dates are not currently communicated preventing C4 from differentiating on accounts to action vs accounts with existing statuses.

# Recommendation

- Do not rely on payload data to measure enrollment success or to take action for consumer outreach efforts.
- Partner with HCPF for projected termination numbers, accounts impacted and termination reason.
- Partner with HCPF for ongoing reporting through the termination process to support outreach and enrollment progress.
