HIAE

The Health Insurance Affordability Enterprise (HIAE) Board continues to work closely with the Division of Insurance (DOI) for implementation and policy planning.

Planning for the End of the PHE

Staff at The Colorado Department of Health Care Policy & Financing (HCPF) and Connect for Health Colorado presented on the <u>public health emergency (PHE) "unwind" coordination</u>. The presentation highlighted working assumptions, the renewal process overview, and communications to members/customers.

RMHP

Patrick Gordon with Rocky Mountain Health Plans (RMHP) briefly discussed the importance of coordination and communication across organizations for the upcoming end of the PHE.

Assistance Network Contracts

The Board reviewed the updated <u>partner application process for fiscal year 2023 - 2024</u> (FY23-24).

Employee Survey

Connect for Heath Colorado launched its Employee Opinion survey to gain employee perspective in relation to seven specific performance components – job satisfaction, engagement, leadership, work culture, work processes, communication, and benefits.

FY 2023 Budget

Staff presented the <u>proposed Budget for FY23</u>. The presentation outlined key budget assumptions, upcoming technology projects, expense comparisons from FY 2021 – 2023, 3-year projections, and financial goals and strategies.
