

Health Insurance Options and Assistance | Alamosa County

Connect for Health Colorado is a new online marketplace where individuals, families and small businesses in Colorado can shop, compare, pick and purchase health insurance plans and get exclusive access to new up-front financial assistance, based on income, to reduce costs. The Marketplace opens in October 2013 and will provide a broad range of health insurance options and expert help in person from Health Coverage Guides and licensed health insurance agents and brokers, and over the phone from Customer Service Center Representatives. Health insurance prices depend on where you live, your age, how many people are covered by your plan and whether you use tobacco products. Nearly 500,000 Coloradans will be eligible for a new kind of tax credit to reduce monthly premiums. Some Coloradans will be eligible for zero-premium health plans. We will also help you access free or low-cost coverage through Medicaid or Child Health Plan Plus. Here's a snapshot of information about choices and assistance in your county.
