Draft Report Overview

- Released by HCPF and DOI on October 8, 2019
- Public option plans will be administered by carriers - not the state
- Plans will be designed with meaningful choice for consumers
- Plans will be available to subsidized and non-subsidized populations as a QHP
- Plans sold through the exchange will be eligible for financial assistance like all other QHPs
- Advisory board established to monitor program
- New plans will be available in Plan Year 2022 (OE 9)

Potential Impacts to C4HCO Customers

Based on information provided in draft report, C4HCO customers could see:

- Lower premiums on individual market
- Reduction in overall amount of APTC awarded to customers
- Simplified plan comparison and shopping
- More carrier choice outside metro area

Analysis may change as specifics become available on plan design, carrier participation, etc.

Next Steps

- Public comment period ends October 25, 2019
- Final report submitted to legislature on November 15, 2019
- Continue engagement on plan design Winter/Spring 2020
- Establish advisory board Summer 2020
- Coverage starts January 1, 2022
