
Medicaid, CHP+ Membership Surge Forecast

- Expecting a membership surge of more than 500,000 Coloradans this coming Fiscal Year
- 40%+ increase to the 1.3M members covered by Medicaid and CHP+ as of March 2020
- When the public health emergency period ends (presumed Dec. 31), we project an **estimated disenrollment of more than 300,000** members who do not meet eligibility criteria.
- Net annual surge of 350,000 Coloradans

Eligibility Criteria for Health First Colorado and CHP+





Individuals Earning Approx. - \$1,415/month (\$16,980/year)

Family of Four Earning Approx. - \$3,101/month (\$37,212/year)

Individuals Earning Approx. – \$2,765/month (\$33,180/year)

Family of Four Earning Approx. – \$5,677/month (\$68,124/year)

- ✓ No enrollment period in either Health First Colorado or CHP+
- ✓ Apply online at Colorado.gov/PEAK 75% of applicants will find out if they're eligible
- ✓ Coloradans can also apply by phone, mail or at their county human services office.
