### I. Welcome & Introductions

# II. Partner Updates

DOI

Staff from the Division of Insurance (DOI) provided the Committee with a Regulatory Update:

- The following rules have been adopted:
  - <u>4-2-53</u>, Network adequacy standard and reporting requirements for ACA-Compliant Health Benefit Plans
  - <u>4-2-54</u>, Network access plan standards and reporting requirements for ACA-Compliant Health Benefit Plans
- The following rules been amended:
  - <u>4-2-55</u>, Standards and reporting requirements for ACA-Compliant Health Benefit Plan provider directories
  - <u>4-2-57</u>. Network adequacy standards and reporting requirements for ACA-Compliant stand-alone dental managed care plans
- The following rules are currently out for public comment:
  - o <u>4-2-78</u>, Concerning cost sharing reduction enhancements
  - <u>4-2-83</u>, Concerning Health Insurance Affordability Enterprise subsidies for qualified individuals through premium wrap and cast sharing reduction enhancements on the Colorado Option Silver Plan

### <u>HCPF</u>

The Department of Health Care Policy & Financing (HCPF) provided the Committee with an update:

• The COVID unwind period began in May. This refers to the 14-month period following the end of the continuous coverage requirement that provides states a timeframe to return to normal eligibility renewal processes for Health First

Colorado and Child Health Plan Plus (CHP+)

• 43K renewal packets were sent out for the May cohort. Thus far, approximately 39% of that population has returned those packets

# III. NBPP Final Rule

Staff presented the <u>final rule for the 2024 payment notice</u>. The presentation highlighted context, timeline, and effective date for notice of benefit & payment parameters for plan year 2024 and the final rule.

### IV. Proposed DACA Rule

The Committee reviewed an <u>update</u> on the Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals (DACA) rule. The presentation highlighted issues, the proposed rule from the Centers of Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS), enrollment options, proposed bill timeline, and the alignment with Connect for Health Colorado's mission and strategic plan.
