Friday Health Plans Update

July 17 Announcements:


- DOI announced that FHP will shut down effective 8/31
 - All current customers need to select a new plan effective 9/1
 - Customers can use a loss of MEC special enrollment period between 7/17 and 10/31 to enroll
- DOI announced an emergency special enrollment period
 - Allowed current Friday customers struggling to access care to enroll in new coverage effective 8/1
 - Special enrollment period between 7/17 and 7/31

Kaiser Permanente and Denver Health have agreed to honor deductible and out of pocket maximum accumulations.




FHP Update: Customers in the beginning of July

Historical Enrollment Data

- When Bright and Oscar left the market,
 70% of customers re-enrolled
 - Consistent with overall marketplace reenrollment. Re-enrollment for the Marketplace is:
 - 2021 = 75%
 - 2022 = 73%
 - 2023 = 70%
- The last mid-year plan exit was Colorado HealthOp in 2016, when 52% of customers re-enrolled



FHP Enrollment Status

Connect for Health Colorado

- 7,712 out of 24,526 customers (31%) reenrolled as of August 7
 - Rural = 1,515 out of 4,596 re-enrolled (33%)
 - Urban = 6,197 out of 19,930 re-enrolled (31%)
 - 2,404 enrolled with an 8/1 start date
 - 5,293 have enrolled with a 9/1 start date

Colorado Connect

- 159 out of 696 customers (23%) re-enrolled as of August 7
 - Rural = 57 out of 170 re-enrolled (34%)
 - Urban = 102 out of 526 re-enrolled (19%)
 - 35 enrolled with an 8/1 start date
 - 124 have enrolled with a 9/1 start date
