**Connect for Health Colorado misappropriated millions of dollars in the first day of the Open Enrollment.**

Connect for Health Colorado deviated from compliance with the Affordable Care Act (ACA) and implemented faulty and illegal procedures to give public benefits ("Free Health Insurance") to unidentified individuals (including violators of state and federal laws).

Example of how health care dollars are being misappropriated is on the snip below:

On November 1, 2023, anyone could create an account on Connect for Health Colorado (DBA Colorado Connect) by using a random email address and award himself/herself with highly subsidized **Colorado Options** Plan.
